Borders Wheels is the unification of 4 Community Transport Organisations in the Borders. Teviot Wheels, Gala Wheels and Tweed Wheels came together first and were joined by Berwickshire Wheels in 2024. This allows Borders Wheels to be a truly Borders wide organisation, supported by staff and volunteer drivers. Borders Wheels has a fleet of accessible vehicles of various sizes for use by individuals, groups and communities across the Scottish Borders. Staff and volunteers also support our three charity shops: Innerleithen, Jedburgh and Lauder.

Set charge calculated at 50p per mile (Individual) and £1.20 per mile (Groups) plus a £10.00 base charge. All trips are charged as a return trip.		
20% VAT will be included where applicable.		
Wait Times: If there is a gap of more than two hours between drop off and collection on a return journey there will be an additional wait charge of £20.00 and further £20.00 for each additional 2 hour block over the initial wait time.		
Surcharge for Out of Hours: Weekdays where pick up is after 6pm, weekends and the Christmas Period (24 Dec - 1 Jan): 20% will be applied to the cost for all users.		
Cleaning: We reserve the right to charge for vehicle valeting if necessary.		
Animals: No pets are permitted in the vehicles unless they are Guide Dogs.		
Cancellation: Full charge on the day, 50% charge with 24 hours notice and no charge if cancelled 48 hours in advance.
